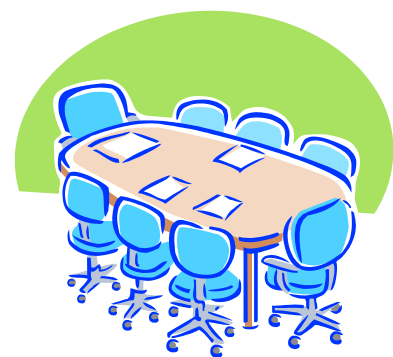

CONSUMER GROUP MEETINGS

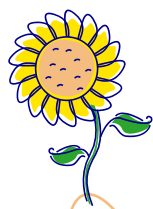
- NORTH — 7 Packham Place, Beachhaven. 10.30-11.30am on the first Tuesday of every month.
